

Early High School Graduate Enrollment Steps

- **[Apply for financial aid as soon as possible](#)**
 - **STLCC's Federal School Code: 002469.**
 - Financial Aid applicants (including Pell and A+) must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit all required financial aid documents to their campus. [Enrollment Services](#) office.
- **[Apply for Admission to STLCC](#)**
 - Choose Application Type: First-Time College.
 - Select Admission Term: Credit Spring 2024
 - Enter Date of HS Graduation of: December 31, 2023.

- **Receive STLCC admissions acceptance letter and email**
 - Use your Student ID number to [retrieve your MySTLCC ID](#)
- **Submit required documents to [STLCC-Registrar's office](#)**
 - **Early HS Graduate Form:** Must be prepared and signed by a school official (principal, counselor, or registrar), and must identify a graduation date that is before January 15, 2024.
 - **Final, official high school transcript with graduation date (and A+ seal if applicable):** must be received by the Registrar's office by Monday, Jan. 29, 2024, via an approved vendor or by USPS mail.
- **Register for classes**
 - Attend Archer Orientation to meet with your Student Success Advisor and register for classes.
 - St. Louis Community College uses multiple measures for placing students into their initial courses. Placement testing **MAY NOT** be required. Discuss your course placement with your admissions counselor.
