

## Renewal of Scholarships

### General Information and Requirements

- A student may reapply each year and may be eligible to receive scholarship funds for a maximum of two academic years (four semesters).
- Scholarship funds are not transferable between campuses.

### Academic

Renewal of scholarships for the second and ensuing semesters shall be contingent on:

- Completing all attempted credit hours: minimum of 12 for full-time or six for part-time students.
- Achieving a 3.0 session GPA.

### Activity

Renewal of scholarships for the second and ensuing semesters shall be contingent on:

- Completing all attempted credit hours: minimum of 12 for full-time or six for part-time students.
- Achieving a 2.0 session GPA.
- Active participation in the selected activity.
- Recommendation of the appropriate activity sponsor.

### Athletic

Renewal of scholarships for the second and ensuing semesters shall be contingent on:

- Athlete meets National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) eligibility requirements;
- Recommendation for continuance by the respective coach and athletic director.

## Purpose

The principal purpose of the St. Louis Community College Board of Trustees Scholarship Program is to recruit and retain students who have above average potential in academics, leadership/extracurricular activity areas or athletics.

## General Information and Requirements

- All applicants must be admitted to STLCC.
- Priority for receiving scholarships will be given to new students, however continuing students may also apply.
- In cases where class rank is not available, other indicators may be used to verify eligibility:
  - GED recipients may use GED exam scores.
  - Home-schooled students may use ACT or SAT scores.
- The maximum value of a scholarship will be at in-district maintenance and activity fees:
  - The value of each scholarship will range from 6 to 16 credit hours.
- The preferred deadline for all scholarship application is **March 31**:
  - Applications received after the deadline will be considered if funding is available.
- Scholarship applicants are encouraged to apply for financial aid.

## Academic Scholarships

Applicants for academic scholarship should rank in the top 20% of their high school class. Students without a class rank may be considered based on other indicators such as a GED score of 2800 or above or a score within the top 20% of Missouri high school seniors on the ACT or SAT exam.

## Activity Scholarships

Activity scholarships are awarded for assuming a leadership role in a student organization or extracurricular activity, or for demonstrating promise in one of the following areas: art, music, drama, speech or campus life. Recommendations for scholarships must be initiated by the appropriate activity sponsor. Applicants should rank in the top 60% of their high school class, have a 2.0 cumulative high school GPA, or an appropriate GED, ACT or SAT score.

## Athletic Scholarships

Athletic scholarship decisions will consider balance among sports as well as equity between male and female athletes. Recommendations for scholarships must be initiated by the appropriate coach or athletic director. Applicants should rank in the top 60% of their high school class, have a 2.0 cumulative high school GPA, or an appropriate GED, ACT or SAT score.
