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This Student Body Profile presents selected academic and demographic information for students enrolled in credit courses at St. Louis Community College. There are four consecutive fall terms in this report (2006 to 2009). The headcount figures reported here are the counts as of census date for the given term (the end of the fourth week of classes), and exclude students who are only auditing classes and students who withdrew from all their classes prior to census date. Campus specific reports present unduplicated headcount. To avoid duplication of counting students and credit hours within a single term, all campus specific values are based on assigning students to a single campus based on where they are enrolled in the majority of their credit hours.

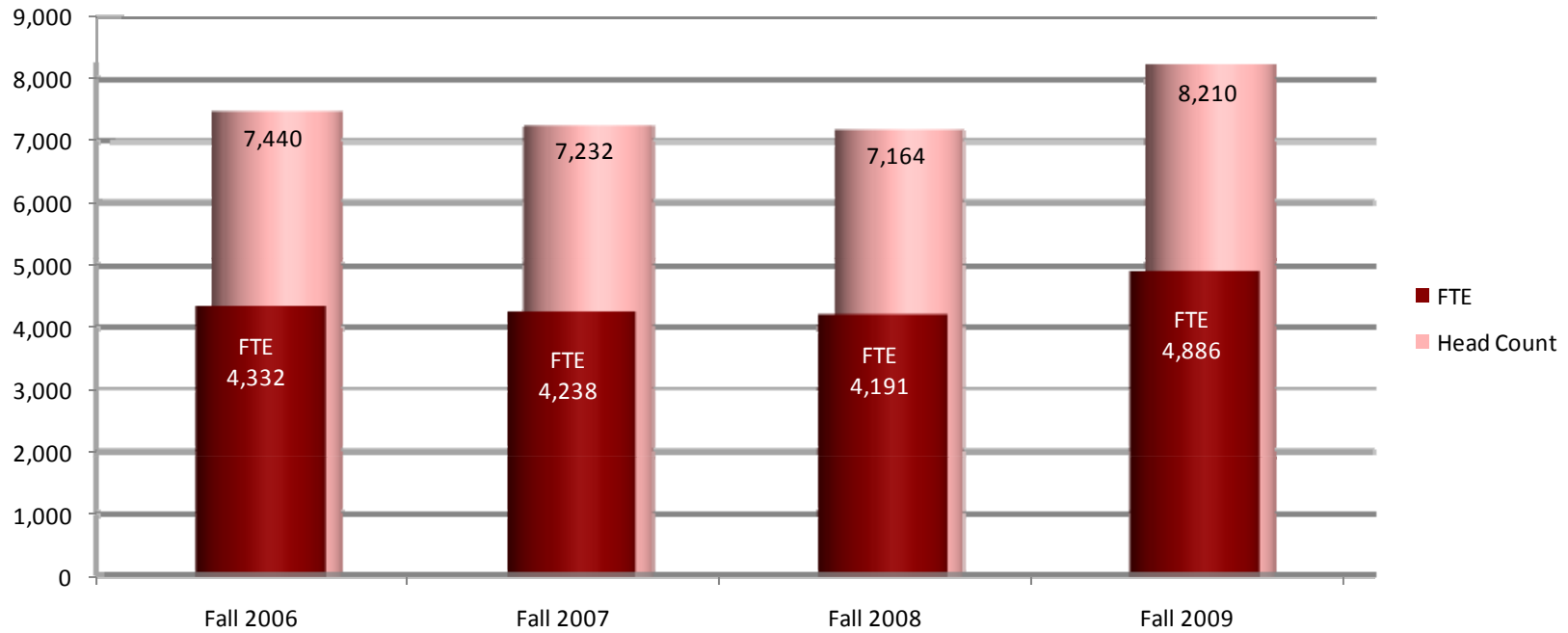
These counts are the same figures reported to the Department of Higher Education. They are published by DHE as the College's "official" enrollment and should, therefore, be used whenever headcount figures are reported externally. The credit hours figures reported here are enrolled hours as of census date for those students enrolled for credit. These hours should not be used for budget purposes. Most budget purposes will require end of session hours including audit hours and hours withdrawn prior to census (0% and 50% refund hours).

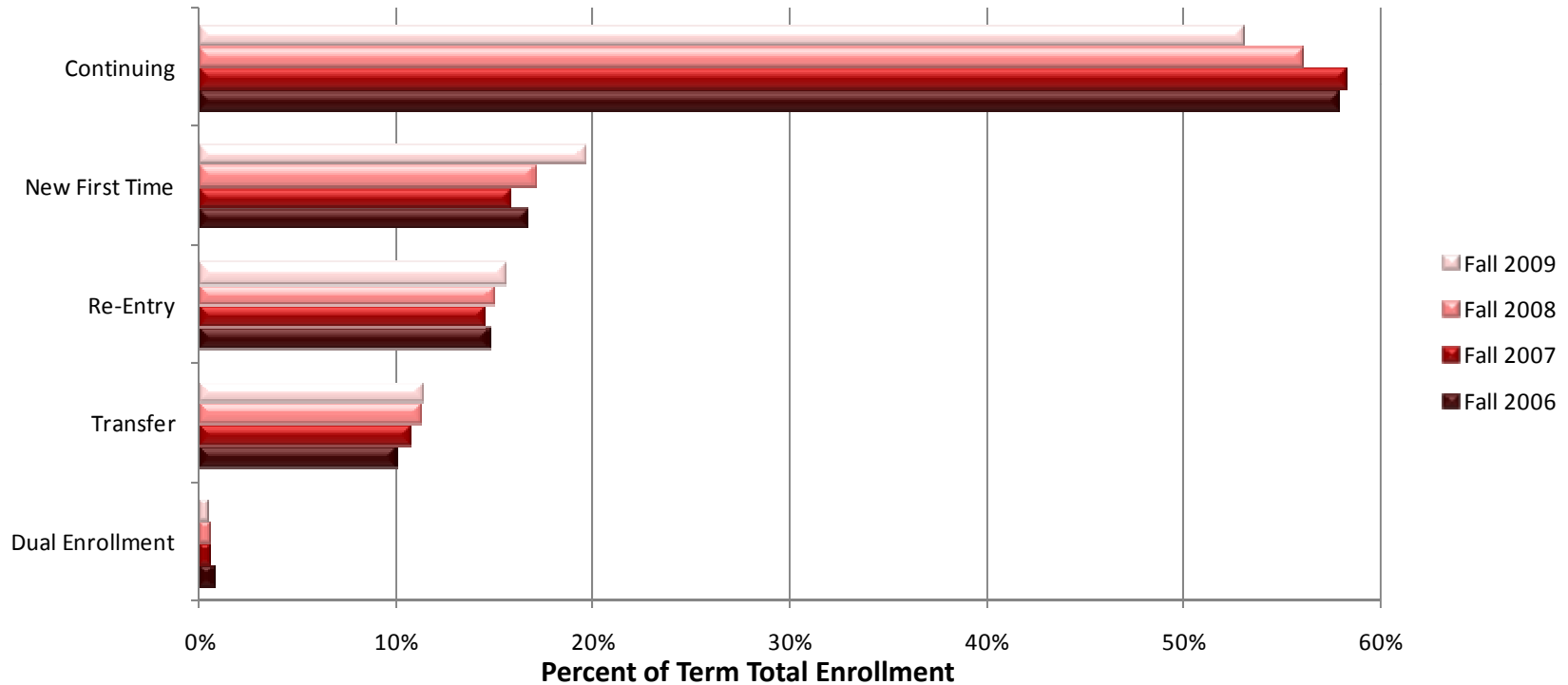

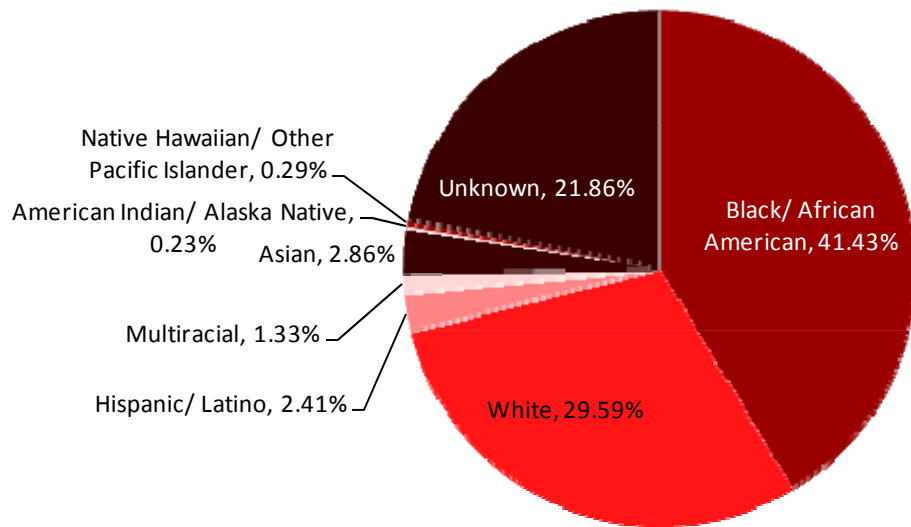

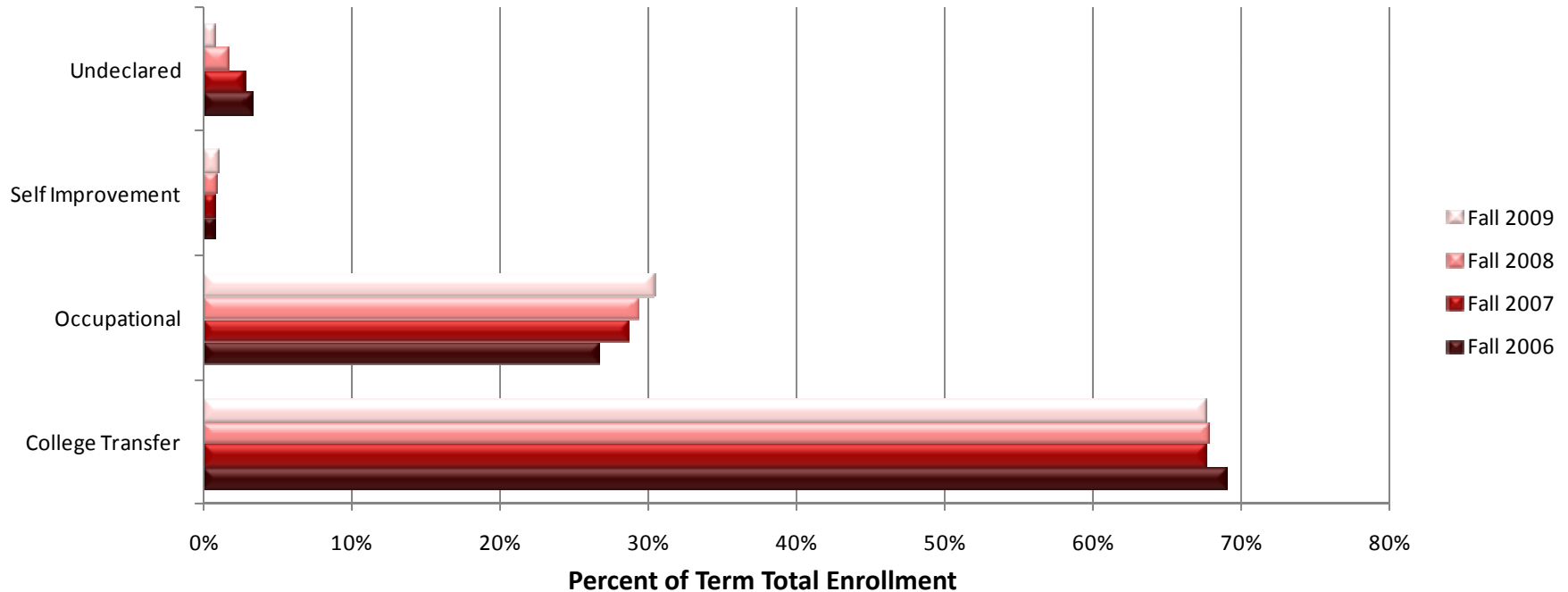

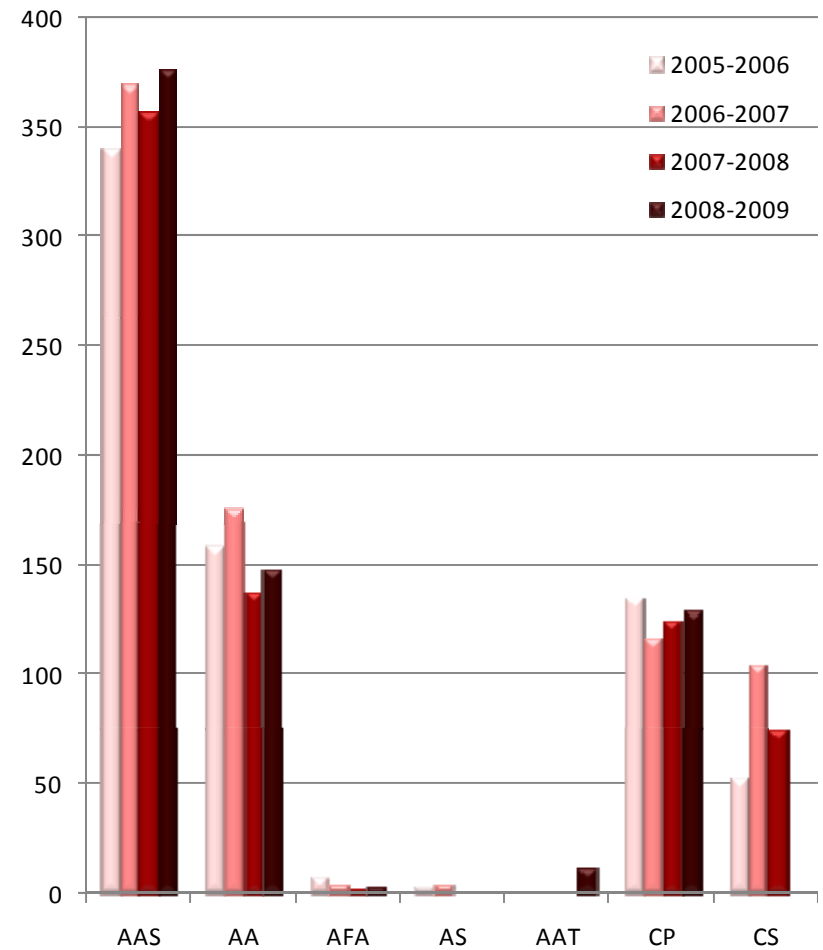

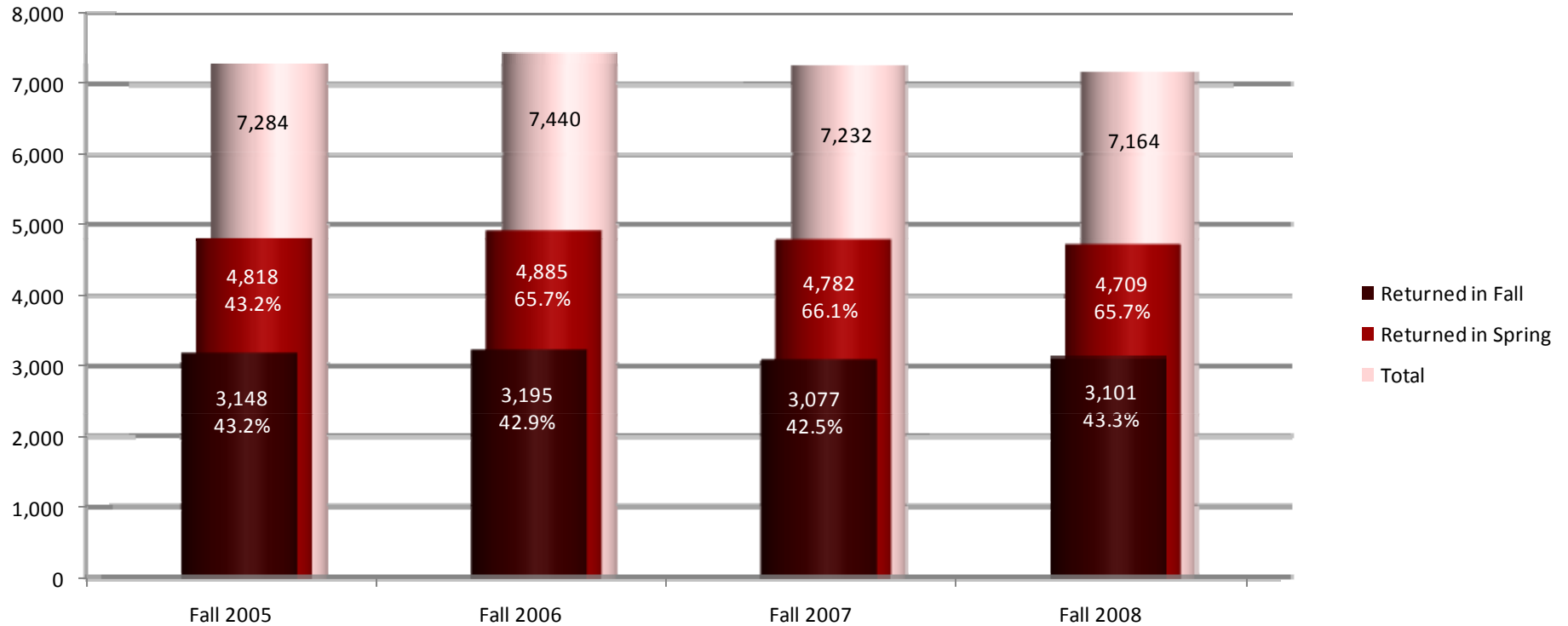

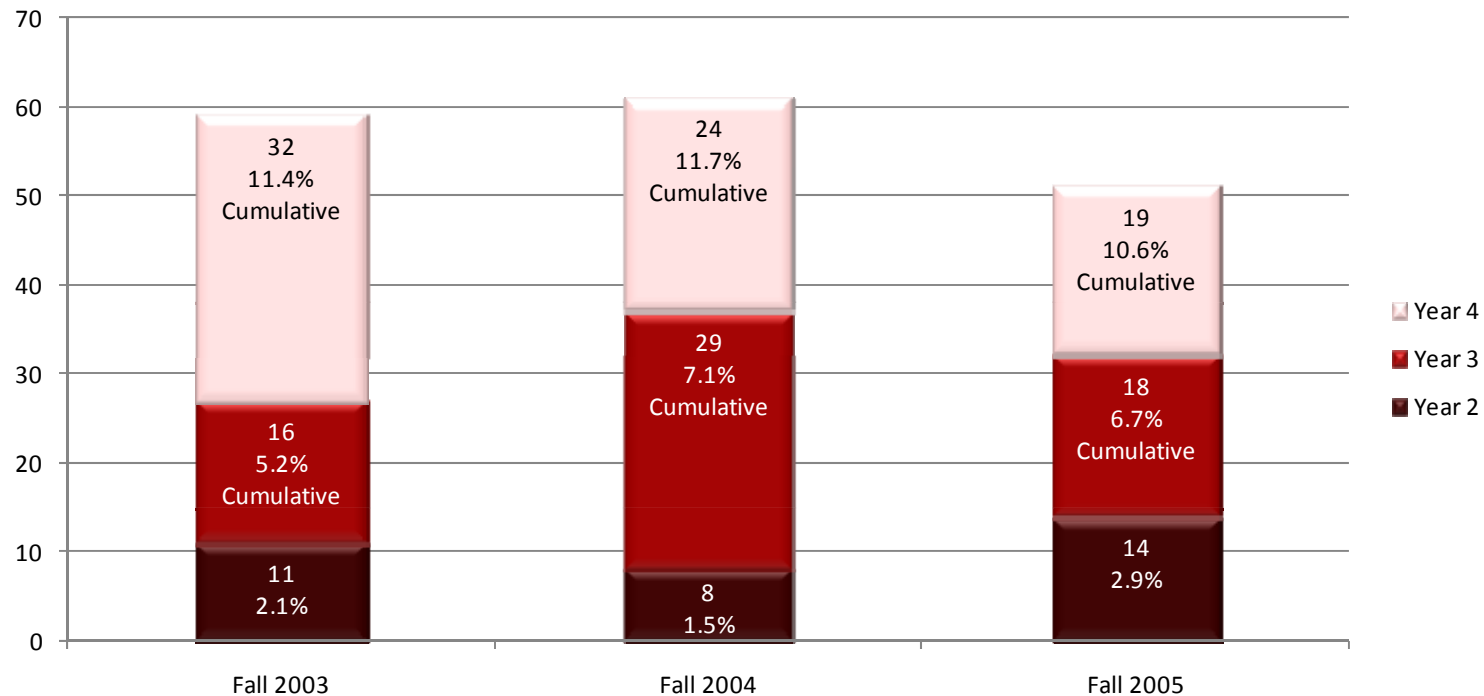
Example interpretation: Of the 7,164 students enrolled at Forest Park in the fall of 2008, 65.7% of them (4,709) returned in the spring term (spring 2009) and 43.3% of them (3,101) were enrolled in the following fall term (fall 2009).



New First Time, Full Time, Degree Seeking Fall Cohort Graduation Data

Example interpretation: Of the 480 New First Time to college, Full Time enrolled, Degree Seeking students for fall 2005, 14 students (2.9% of the cohort) had graduated by the end of their second year, 18 (cumulative 6.7%) by the end of their third year, and 19 (cumulative 10.6%) by the end of their fourth year.

Cohorts for each fall term are comprised of New First Time, Full Time, Degree Seeking students enrolled at census date. Follow-up years are based on the subsequent academic years and are defined above. Graduation includes any completed degree or certificate. Data reported includes number of graduates by year and cumulative percent of original cohort. Count is UNDUPLICATED such that a student in the cohort is only counted as graduating once - upon receipt of his/her first degree/certificate earned.

New First Time, Full Time, Degree Seeking Fall Cohort Retention Data

Example interpretation: Of the 480 New First Time to college, Full Time enrolled, Degree Seeking students for fall 2005, 58.8% (282 students) were enrolled in the next academic year, 41.5% (199) in year three, and 26.3% (126) of the original group were enrolled in year four.
