CAREER SHADOWING

Prior to applying to the Radiologic Technology program offered at St. Louis Community College at Forest Park, a student must complete 8 hours of job shadowing in the **general radiology** department of a hospital.

- This experience must be documented on the form below and submitted upon application to the program.
- Shadowing may be done at 2 different facilities, 4 hours at each facility.
- Only 4 hours of shadowing may be completed at a children's hospital.
- The student arranges this on their own by contacting the human resources department of the hospital of their choice.
- Several area hospitals offer information about "job shadowing" on their websites.
- Shadowing at clinics, physician offices, outpatient imaging centers, surgery centers, etc. will not be accepted because the purpose of this experience is to expose students to the environment they will encounter throughout the program.
