BACHELOR OF FINE ARTS in INTERIOR DESIGN

Students who have completed the 42 hour general education core at St. Louis Community College or students with the following Associate in Arts (AA) degrees from St. Louis Community College will have fulfilled Maryville University's General Education requirements: General Transfer, Business Administration, Communication Arts, Liberal Arts, Life Sciences, and Mathematics.

Students without an associate degree or having any other AA, AS, AFA, or AAS degree must complete Maryville University's General Education requirements as part of their degree completion program. Transfer course work will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis to determine equivalency. Students should follow Bachelor's Degree General Education Requirements as stated on the BA/BS, BFA Transfer Guide.

Transfer students applying for admission to the Interior Design program must first meet the general admission requirements (minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA). To complete the admission process you must submit an official transcript from St. Louis Community College and any other college/university attended. Each transcript is reviewed to determine transferability of credits and whether all general education requirements have been met. An entrance portfolio is also required and reviewed to determine admission status, applicability of transfer credits, and placement in the Interior Design program. Space within the program is limited, so early application is strongly encouraged.

MAJOR AND DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

BFA in Interior Design:

- 132 total credit hours
- 60 credit hours must be completed at a four year institution
- 90 credit hours in interior design major
- 45 credit hours in interior design must be completed at Maryville University
- Maximum of 45 credit hours in art and interior design courses may be accepted
