

RESPIRATORY CARE - AAS Advising Checklist

Admission to the College does not guarantee admission to the Respiratory Care Program. Before submitting a respiratory care program application, students must have successfully completed all **pre-application requirements listed below (items 1-8).**

- _____ 1. **Application Form** for admission to the College.
- _____ 2. **Degree Seeking Status**, which requires:
 - _____ **Official College Transcripts: An official transcript from each college attended must be sent directly from the college attended to Central Student Records, St. Louis Community College, 300 S. Broadway, St. Louis, MO 63102. Hand-carried or faxed transcripts will not be accepted.**
 - _____ **High School Transcript or GED:** High school students with fewer than 15 hours of college level work must submit a final high school transcript to be sent directly from the high school to Central Student Records, St. Louis Community College, 300 S. Broadway, St. Louis, MO 63102.
- _____ 3. **Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5** (4.0 scale) in high school or for 15 hours of college work (100 level or higher). Students with fewer than 15 hours of college credit must have both a 2.5 GPA in high school and a 2.5 GPA in college.
 - **2.5 GPA MUST be maintained while on the waiting list AND throughout the respiratory care program.**
 - **GED Applicants:** must have 15 hours of (100 level or higher) college credit with a 2.5 GPA or higher
 - **STLCC students with at least 15 college level credits with a 2.5 GPA:** will have met this requirement, regardless of the GPA at other colleges.
 - **College transfer students with fewer than 15 STLCC credits:** must have a cumulative 2.5 GPA in college level credits earned at all colleges attended.
- _____ 4. **Reading: Complete one of the following to meet the reading prerequisite**
 - Composite ACT score of 18 or higher **OR** SAT verbal score of 500 or higher (**within the last 3 years**)
 - Accuplacer score of 77 or higher **OR** Compass score of 82 or higher on the Reading portion (**within the last 3 years**)
 - Completion of RDG 030 **OR** ENG 070 with a “C” grade or higher **OR** proof of completion of a 3 credit hour course (100 level or higher) with a “C” grade or higher from a U.S. accredited institution.
 - Students who have met the college’s reading proficiency have also met the reading requirement for respiratory care.
- _____ 5. **English: Complete one of the following to meet the English prerequisite:**
 - Composite ACT score of 18 or higher **OR** SAT verbal score of 500 or higher (**within the last 3 years**)
 - Accuplacer score of 83 or higher on the Sentence Skills portion (**within the last 3 years**) **OR** Compass score of 70 or higher on the Writing Skills portion (**within the last 3 years**)
 - Completion of ENG 030 or ENG 070 with a “C” grade or higher

- _____6. **Math: Complete one of the following to meet the math prerequisite:**
- Math ACT score of 22 or higher **OR** SAT math score of 580 or higher (**within the last 3 years**)
 - Placement into MTH160 or higher on the Accuplacer **OR** Compass (**within the last 3 years**)
 - Completion of MTH124 or higher level math with a “C” or higher (**within the last 5 years**)
- _____7. **Chemistry:** Students are required to have completed two semesters of high school chemistry with lab, or one semester of college chemistry with lab (STLCC CHEM101 or higher) with a “C” grade or higher **within 5 years** of applying to the respiratory care program.
- _____8. **Anatomy & Physiology I (STLCC BIO207):**
- Anatomy & Physiology (with a lab) (STLCC BIO207) must be completed with a “C” or higher **within 5 years** of application to the respiratory care program.
 - Prerequisite to A&P I: General Biology (STLCC BIO111) with a grade of “C” or better **OR** one year of high school biology (with lab) within five years of registration date **OR** permission of the department chairperson of Biology

WHEN THE ABOVE CRITERIA HAVE BEEN MET, STUDENTS MUST MEET WITH AN ADVISOR AT THE FOREST PARK CAMPUS TO SUBMIT A RESPIRATORY CARE PROGRAM APPLICATION.

The following requirements must be completed in order to enroll into the first semester of the respiratory care program:

- _____9. **Anatomy & Physiology II (STLCC BIO208):** Completion with a “C” grade or higher
